The purpose of this note, and the many that will follow, is to provide you with recent and immediate future activity concerning the Second Street TIGER grant project.

- The major project work in the section between Taylor Avenue and Conway Street is in its final stages. Over the next several weeks, the sidewalk, storm drainage, roadway, and overhead utility relocation will be completed. In continuing to move along the Second Street corridor, it is necessary for the Frankfort Plant Board Water and Pace Contracting sanitary sewer teams to continue working between Conway Street and Bridge Street and onto Bridge Street itself. Their work needs to be completed before Pace Contracting can follow-up with the storm drainage, sidewalk, and roadway activities. All of this Bridge Street work is expected to take a few months to complete.
- Beginning Tuesday, July 27th, Bridge Street will be closed to accommodate the work described above. ROAD CLOSED signs will be placed at the St. Clair Street end of the Singing Bridge. A Bridge Street detour will be signed on the downtown side of the river. Local traffic may cross the Singing Bridge to park and patronize Bridge Street businesses. The parking area will be between the floodwall and the Singing Bridge. Pedestrians will still be able to walk across the Singing Bridge and along Bridge Street. Additional parking will be available in the City parking lot on the corner of Second Street and Conway Street.
- The City has created a way for people to keep up with the overall status of the project by using #trackthetiger on the City of Frankfort Facebook page.

Important note: This project will be impacting the numerous businesses located adjacent to the project. These businesses are located along Second Street, Bridge Street, Capital Avenue, and East/West Main Streets. In particular, sections of Second Street and Bridge Street will be closed from time to time to through traffic. The contractor is required to provide local access to these businesses. Despite this local access, there will be occasional parking restrictions. The City will be working with the contractor to ensure local access and maximize available parking as construction activity permits. The City will be coordinating with other agencies to publicize that these businesses are open and need your support.

We continue to develop a project stakeholder list with contact information so that we may keep interested parties informed of project status. We are also developing a separate property owner list with contact information. Please feel free to share this note with others.
