

ORDINANCE NO. 4, 2023 SERIES

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 40.23 OF THE CITY OF FRANKFORT CODE OF ORDINANCES RELATED TO POLICE DEPARTMENT PROMOTIONS

WHEREAS, to improve efficiency, the City of Frankfort desires to remove promotional requirements for police officers from the ordinance and place them in the Police Department Policies and Procedures;

NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED by the Board of Commissioners of the City of Frankfort that Section 40.23 of the City of Frankfort Code of Ordinances is hereby amended as follows:

§ 40.23 POLICE DEPARTMENT PROMOTIONS.

(A) Upon the request of the City Manager, the Board of Civil Service shall hold competitive examinations for those members of the Police Department for the purpose of establishing an eligibility list for potential promotion to the ranks of Police Sergeant, Police Lieutenant, and Police Captain. Employees that will become eligible for promotion within one year following the testing date shall be eligible to take the promotional exam.

(B) The Police Department's Policy and Procedure 202.01 shall establish administration of the testing, appointment of the applicants and review of the appointment for a probationary period. Any changes will be reviewed by the City Manager, City Solicitor and Human Resources Director if necessary.

Summary: This ordinance amends Section 40.23 of the City of Frankfort Code of Ordinances related to Police Department promotions to 1) Reference the Police Department's Policy and Procedure 202.01 which establishes standards for and administration of the promotional testing, appointment of the applicants, and review of the appointment for a probationary period; 2) Require that changes to the Policy shall be reviewed by the City Manager, City Attorney, and/or Human Resources Director as necessary; and 3) Delete the remaining provisions governing promotional requirements, as these are now established by policy.
